

PHOTOGRAPHY

You don't need to be a photographer and / or own an expensive camera to produce a nice picture. Your mobile phone will probably have a very good camera on it. Have a go at the following classes. The judge is looking for photos which reflect the title and description, so many pictures could fit and win without being taken by an expert.

51	Moment in Time	Set of 5 photos mounted on board, showing same subject at different times/activities/seasons. Creativity of display of photos will affect the judging eg photo size, order, overlapping, etc. Subject could be a person, animal, landscape, garden, building etc. The judge will be looking for the photos to tell a story. A cryptic title of no more than 6 words <u>may</u> be used.
52	Visit Staffordshire or Visit Derbyshire	A set of 3 photos illustrating the best of the county; think of them as an advert to encourage a tourist to visit. Could be three separate locations or one. A theme running through the pictures would be nice but not essential. In a concise title, not exceeding 6 words, indicate the location(s).
53	Wild Thing	A single photo showing the wild aspect of nature. A cryptic title of no more than 6 words <u>may</u> be used.
54	Humorous	Single photo to make the judge smile. A cryptic title of no more than 6 words <u>may</u> be used. Remember this is a family show.
55	What am I?	Single photo showing a close up or an unusual view of an object. Cryptic clue of no more than 6 words <u>may</u> be supplied to indicate the identity of the object. Remember this is a family show. Identity of the object to be written on the back of the photo.
