SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

ALL ENTRANTS MUST LIVE WITHIN 20 MILES OF DRAYCOTT-IN-THE-CLAY
RING 1 – 9.30am IN HAND CLASSES

Class 1	Veteran In Hand. Mares or Geldings, 16 Years old and over.
Class 2	Open in Hand. Mares or Geldings, 4 Years old and over.

All handlers must wear suitable clothing and footwear and wear a hard hat.

RING 1 – 10.00am (approx) RIDDEN CLASSES

Class 3	Best Turned Out Pony & Rider. 13.2 & Under including Lead Rein
Class 4	Best Turned Out Horse/Pony. 13.2 & Over
Class 5	Best Rider – Lead Rein or First Ridden. Rider 11 years and under on date of show. Walk & Trot only. (Entrants in this class may not enter Class 6)
Class 6	Best Rider. Rider 16 years and under on date of show.
Class 7	Best Horse/Pony. Open to Mares and Geldings, 4 years old and over. To be judged on an individual show. There will be an optional small jump which, if taken will gain extra points.
Class 8	Handy Pony – Including Lead Rein
Class 9	Open Mounted Fancy Dress. To be judged in the Main Ring after the ridden classes. A hard had must be incorporated into the costume.

RING 2 – 9.30am onwards CLEAR ROUND

9.30 to 10.30	INTRO CLEAR ROUND - Suitable for Lead Rein and First Ridden Pony.
10.30 to 11.30	OPEN CLEAR ROUND - Max 2ft (60cm)

All of the above classes may be divided or amalgamated according to age or height at the organisers' discretion, depending on entries.

Entry fees: £5 Per Class - £3 Clear Round or £5 for 2 Rounds

All Entries On The Day

Rules

1. The Judge's decision is final.
2. The organisers accept no responsibility for accident, injury, loss or damage to any person, animal or vehicle attending the show. All competitors take part **AT THEIR OWN RISK.**
3. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry, especially if they consider an entrant may be a danger to themselves or others.
4. Correct British Standard Headgear conforming to current standards must be worn at all times when mounted.
5. In ridden classes, horses and ponies must be 4 years old or over.
6. All horses and ponies to be kept in designated areas.
7. All dogs to be kept on leads.
8. All competitors and their attendants to be polite to Judges and Stewards at all times.
9. Competitor's age as on day of show.
10. All entries to be made on the showground on the day of the show.
11. All entrants must hand in a signed and completed entry form to the Horse & Pony Secretary.
